1. Purpose

1.1. The purpose of this procedure is to outline the guidelines and requirements for visitors at the MTech Mobility locations: Jupiter, FL, Norcross, GA, and Wexford, Ireland.

2. Scope

- 2.1. The scope of this procedure is for any site visitor at the Jupiter, FL, Norcross, GA, and Wexford, Ireland MTech Mobility locations and is included but not limited to:
 - 2.1.1. Customers
 - 2.1.2. Third party service providers
 - 2.1.3. External auditors
 - 2.1.4. MTech or Customer's Insurance and Financial Auditors

3. Responsibility

3.1. It is the responsibility of onsite management to ensure that all visitors are aware and follow the requirements of this procedure.

4. Rules and Requirements

- 4.1. All visitors agree to read and acknowledge a Non-Disclosure and Waiver Agreement prior to having access to the MTech Mobility locations: Jupiter, FL, Norcross, GA, and Wexford, Ireland.
- 4.2. All visitors must sign in and out through the main entrance.
- 4.3. All visitors acknowledge and agree to the use of video surveillance throughout the MTech Mobility locations: Jupiter, FL, Norcross, GA, and Wexford, Ireland.
- 4.4. Visitors will be provided an overview of our safety requirements and exits, etc.
- 4.5. Unless otherwise guided during the tour, visitors should remain within the identified walkways.
- 4.6. All visitors must wear their visitor sign in badge and provided vest at all times.
- 4.7. Closed toed flat shoes are required on the production floor. Under no circumstances are shoes with heels, open sides, or open backs acceptable on the production floor.
- 4.8. All guests must be always escorted by an MTech employee.
- 4.9. Wi-Fi access is provided to visitors where required through the guest network. Password will be provided after arrival.
- 4.10. No food or drink is permissible on the production floor.
- 4.11. Smoking and tobacco use is prohibited in the Integration Center.
- 4.12. Upon entry and exit of the production area of the facility:
- 4.12.1. <u>Jupiter and Norcross Only:</u> Individuals will be required to walk through a metal detection screen. If the alarm triggers a Security Representative will do an additional swipe with a handheld metal detector.
- 4.12.2. All personnel electronics including phones, tablets, and computers must remain in the office area. Any bags being brought to the production floor may be subjected to an additional search.
- 4.13. Firearms or other weapons are prohibited in the MTech Mobility locations: Jupiter, FL, Norcross, GA, and Wexford, Ireland.
- 4.14. Recording devices of any kind such as (cameras, mobile phones, tablets, etc.) are prohibited in the MTech Mobility locations: Jupiter, FL, Norcross, GA, and Wexford, Ireland.
